

National Curriculum Requirements for Swimming by the end of KS2

- **Academic Year 2016-2017 out of 30 children in the year 6 cohort, 30** are meeting the national curriculum requirement to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
- **Academic Year 2017-2018 out of 31 children in the year 6 cohort, 29** are meeting the national curriculum requirement to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
- **Academic Year 2018-2019 out of 33 children in the year 6 cohort, 31** are meeting the national curriculum requirement to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations. 2 children are currently receiving additional swimming intervention to be ready for secondary school.
- **Looking ahead for next Academic Year 2019-2020** out of 34 children in our current year 5 cohort, 33 are meeting the national curriculum requirement to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations. Swimming interventions are in place to ensure that all children achieve the expected standards.
