Our teams of year 4 and year 5 children made our school proud with their enthusiasm, hard work, perseverance and great teamwork on the day. The morning was a steep learning curve, learning coding skills for a first time and applying them to program an EV3 robot to fulfill a number of missions on a field mat - each with a different range of difficulty and gaining them a different number of points. The children used variables, loops, decision commands and sensors (touch sensor, ultrasonic sensor and light sensor) to devise rather complicated programs which they tested and improved in the afternoon.
