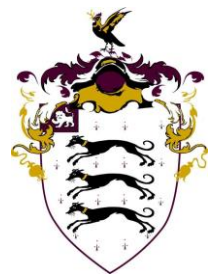
School Uniform

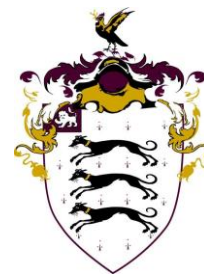
Governors' Wall
