Can you spare an hour or two to help? The children can join you and play after school.

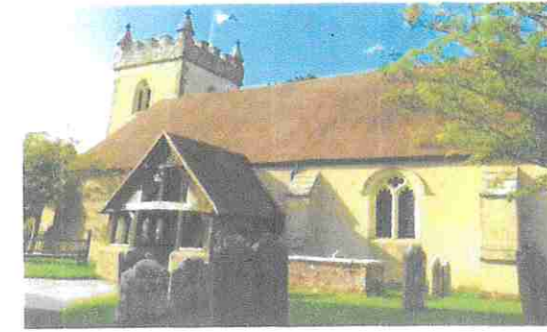

**Mile of Pennies  
Community Project  
at All Saints, Headley  
11am until 2pm**

To achieve the mile we need to collect 84,480 pennies.

It is a fun event for the whole community to join in.

A pint container (eg a milk bottle) will hold approximately 640 pennies, weighing 2.2784 kg, and will represent 40 ft of the mile (16 pennies equals 1 ft). We will need 132 pints of pennies weighing together just over 300 kg.

To help the collections both 1p and 2p coins will be used. All proceeds will support the clock and tower restoration fund at the church.
