Sporting – Gold

Wonderful news for Middleton St Mary's...we have achieved the School Games Gold Mark Award this year. This acknowledges our commitment to the development of competition across the school and into our community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success.



Our sporting achievements this year include: Silver Medallists at the West Yorkshire Finals; crowned Active Schools Champions at Y3/4 tennis, Y6 triathlon, Y5/6 girls and KS1 come and try football; finishing 2nd in the boy's football league and Leeds South and Central Y4/5/6 athletics. In total, 240 KS2 pupils have competed across the year and taken part in after school clubs...this is amazing!

A special thanks goes to Miss Kellett, our Sports Coach, and all staff, children and parents who have supported us this year. We often need volunteers for these events, please pop in and let us know if you may be available 2019-20 as we aim to increase participation and go for platinum next year! 😊

Y1 Phonics Screen – Great news!

80% of our Y1 pupils have passed the national phonics screen this year. We are really pleased as this is a significant improvement on last year's results of 70% and the previous year of 42%! Our cumulative total for Year 1 and 2 for children currently in Year 2 is 95%, 4% above National. Well done to the Key Stage 1 team! 😊

Y2 SATs

Our KS1 SATs results are moving in the right direction, despite being still some way off National. Reading has increased 10% to 52%, Writing by 22% to 53%, Maths by 9% to 50% and Reading, Writing, Maths combined by 17% to 41%. We were moderated by the Local Authority this year. Well done to all staff involved and to parents/carers for your support, we are moving in the right direction!

KS2 SATs – Year 6

We are really pleased with our Year 6 pupils this year, they showed great resilience during SATs week, thanks to the Year 6 teachers for preparing them for this. Whilst our results remain low, we have seen impact in Maths with an increase of children achieving the expected standard of 29% from 29% to 58%. Whilst this is still low, the staff and children have worked hard to achieve this. Reading and Writing remain low at 41% and 44%, despite all of the hard work we have put into reading. We need your support as parents to support your child with reading, listening to your child read daily at home to aid their fluency, comprehension and understanding.
