Year 6 leaving Harefield Junior School

Year 6 will be leaving us next Tuesday and we would like wish them all the very best for the future. They have been a great year group. Reading Around the Solar System Competition

As an encouragement to get children to regularly read aloud at home, Harefield Junior School use the 'Read Around the Solar System' scheme. Together with their reading book children will have a Planet Card. When they have filled up all 15 rockets (i.e. read for 15 days aloud to an adult) they get to take off to the next planet and read again for 15 days (they will also receive a certificate). Once a planet card has been completed it can be posted into the reading competition box in the school library. Then at the end of each term, a card is drawn from the box (a bit like a tombola) and winners are chosen and awarded a prize at assembly. We are delighted to announce that Rose Nemenyi (4 Elm), Ryan McGovern Dupree (4 Maranti) and Peter O'Hara (6 Beech) were the winners for this term.

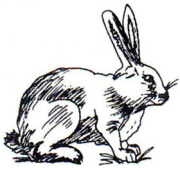

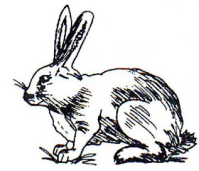
