Thank you to parents and carers for their support during Environmental Week at school. We had an amazing talk from the Plastic Pollution Coalition on Monday. Several classes took part in their workshops. Year 5 had a special visitor in their class who taught them how to make reusable bees' wax wraps.

On Tuesday, Suez came to speak with us about recycling and reusing. Thank you to everyone who bought in milk containers (and bought spares for others). The elephants and plant pots looked fantastic.

On Wednesday we finished with our plastic free picnic on the field. Thank you to everyone who made an amazing effort to provide their child with a plastic free lunch. Thank you to parents who came and ate their lunch with us too!

From now on, the school packed lunches will be plastic free! A reminder bottle tops can go into your plastic recycling (we checked with Suez!) There is also a drop-off point for crisp packets at Nanpean School!

Plastic Free Lunches at Roche School!



The packed lunch above is provided by our school kitchen. It is plastic wrapper free and can all be recycled. The fruit and vegetable sticks provide 2 of your child's 5-a-day. The 50/50 bread contains carbohydrates and the ham is a source of protein. When the school packed lunch sandwich/wrap contains cheese, your child is getting calcium.

The School Packed lunches are free for KS1 and Free School Meal KS2 children. Otherwise, they cost only £2.30.
