

Warley Primary School School Uniform Policy

SCHOOL UNIFORM CODE

We want students to look smart in their school uniform at all times. Appearance is important, both in school and travelling to and from school. We feel it is important that students have pride in their school and to respect its uniform by wearing it neatly.



Trousers/

Plain, grey formal style trousers/shorts. Belt, if worn, must be plain black with no decorative buckle.

Shorts

Skirt/Dress

Grey, knee length skirt or pinafore. In the summer months, light blue or dark blue gingham dress. Summer dresses must be full gingham and not plain white on top. (Please note that girls may wear trousers, skirts or a pinafore.)

/Trousers

Polo Shirt

Sky blue polo shirt. Polos with school logos are available from Havering School Wear.

Shoes

Plain black leather/leather look shoes with no decoration. Plain black leather ankle boots may be worn. Black laces only. **No Trainers or Trainer style shoes even if completely black.**

Jumper/ Cardigan

(if required) Navy blue with school logo, available from Havering School Wear.

Socks

Plain, grey, white, black or navy.

Tights

Plain, flesh, black or grey. No leggings.

Coats

Navy blue school coat/reversible fleece available from Havering School Wear. It is desirable that all pupils wear the school coat with logo, particularly if children regularly attend school sporting events. However, if parents choose not to buy the school coat, coats must be as plain as possible and **navy blue or black**. No hoodies.

PE

Navy blue PE polo with logo, black football shorts and trainers. A school jacket/reversible fleece can be worn for lessons and sporting events. We hope to make a school tracksuit available in the future. If joggers are to be worn for PE **they must be Navy**.

Bags

KS1 children must use the school book bag as it is essential that their bag can fit into their tidy tray.

KS2 children - it is desirable that all pupils use the school backpack, however, if children use an alternative bag, it should be black or navy blue.

Space in our cloakrooms is extremely limited. We would therefore recommend purchasing the school backpack as it is large enough to contain additional sports kits without the need to bring two bags.

Hair

Any hair colouring should be of a 'natural' colour. **The length should be a grade 5 minimum on top and a minimum of grade 3 on the side and back and should be without words, patterns, lines or emblems. Extremes in difference of length are not allowed!** It is the pupil's/parents' responsibility to ensure their hair is clean and kept in a presentable style. **Accessories should be small and either blue, black or grey.** Large bows are not allowed, even if in keeping with the uniform colours.

Hair below chin length must be tied back in a neat and tidy fashion.

Cosmetics

Make up is not permitted. For obvious safety reasons, false nails are not appropriate in school. Nail varnish, French manicure or nail decoration of any kind is not allowed.

Jewellery

(if required) Wrist watch. One small plain silver/gold stud earring may be worn in lower lobes and these will need to be removed for PE lessons.

These guidelines attempt to create a uniform and appearance which is appropriate for school wear. Appropriateness can be disputed, but, in an attempt to ensure consistency, the School's Senior Leadership, in consultation with the Governing Body, respectfully reserve the right to determine what is appropriate and what is not.

We cannot allow slogans, patterns or words to appear in any school uniform or personal appearance.

Parents are advised to consult with the School prior to purchasing any item of uniform or change in personal appearance which could conflict with the Uniform Code.
