The Children's University at Copley Junior School



At Copley Junior School, we are proud to be a member of the Children's University.

The Children's University is an opportunity for children to be rewarded for spending time involved in activities outside school hours. Children record each hour that they complete in an activity at a Children's University Learning Destination in their Children's University 'Passport to Learning'. All learning destinations are accredited by the Children's University and include clubs organised by Copley Junior School as well as many other local clubs for swimming, dance, martial arts etc.

Children are encouraged to work towards national certificates that are issued from the Children's University. Certificates can be awarded up to 1000 hours. The first award starts with the bronze certificate at the Undergraduate level of 30 hours of learning. One of our pupils, Matilda R, has just achieved the highest award of the Gold Fellowship for achieving over 1000 hours of extra-curricular learning and she is the second Copley pupil to achieve this! This year our graduates have achieved an amazing **9 400** hours of extra-curricular learning.



Once a year, children are invited to a graduation ceremony. In July, seventy one of our pupils, wearing their cap and gown, graduated and received their certificate in front of an invited audience of over 100 parents, relatives and

governors at the Hub in Doncaster. We took lots of photographs to mark the occasion!
