### Sixth Form Exam Results 2019

In the midst of the summer break the waiting was over for our Year 12 and 13 students as they received their results. The number of students sitting A Levels in Year 13 was 60 and St Gregory's celebrated 94 per cent pass rate at A level with 26 per cent A\* - B grades being achieved whilst 59 per cent of the results were A\* - C grades.

For the individual students what matters is whether they've done well enough to get into the university or the training course of their choice. They follow our tradition of students from our sixth form going on to top universities.

This year's results will mean almost all of our students got their first choice places. We would like to congratulate all of our students and we are immensely proud of their achievement, some of whom have done exceptionally well. Among the top performers celebrating were:

Carmen Powell (Head Girl) who achieved an A in Biology, an A in Chemistry and an A in Mathematics, she is going on to study Medicine at Cardiff.

Stan Majewski did equally well with an A in Biology, an A in Chemistry and an A Physics, he too will go on to study Medicine.

Sabrina Hussain achieved an A in Biology, an A in Chemistry and an A in Mathematics, she is going on to study Psychology.

Headteacher, Sean Tucker said: "Of course we are delighted with the results, but our real reason for celebration is the fact that almost all our students have secured the results they need for the next stage in their journey. A huge thank you to all the staff and families who have worked hard and in partnership to achieve some pleasing results.
