Year 5 Arrive in Asia!

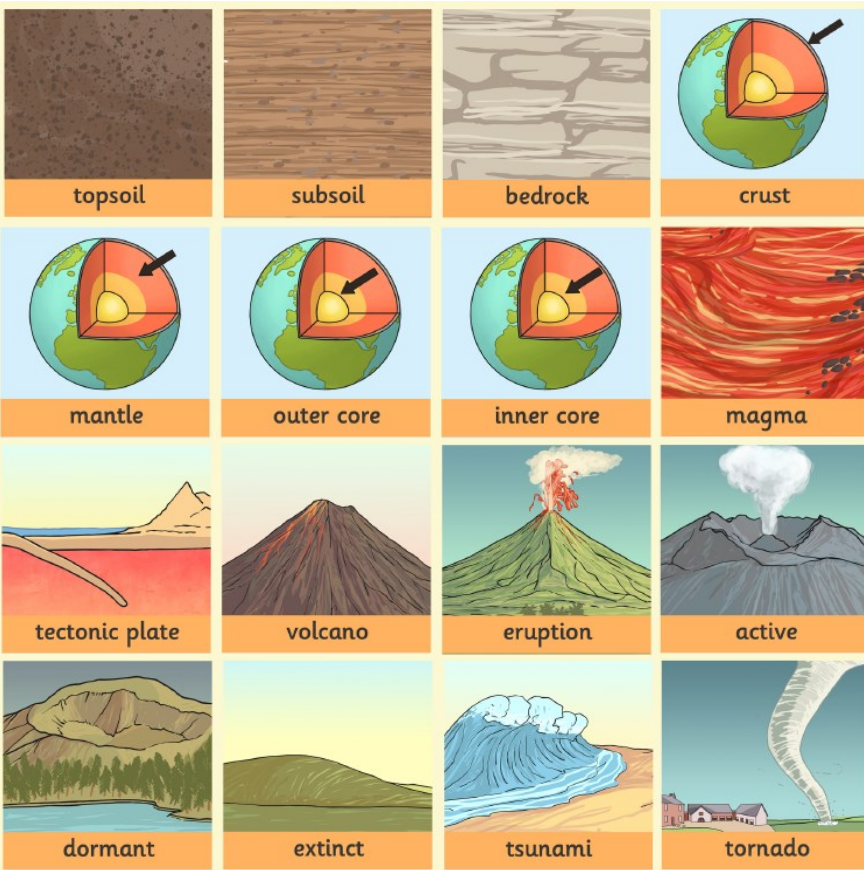
Arrive in Asia is an exciting unit of work which includes three distinct elements. We will firstly study 'Early Islamic Civilisation' where the children will learn in detail about the significance and importance of Baghdad in helping to build and shape this early civilisation. We will learn about how and why it developed into such a major world power. We will then move onto 'Extreme Earth' where we look at volcanoes, earthquakes, tsunamis and tornadoes and the effect they have on people and places. Lastly, we will do an in depth study of 'Chembakolli' which is one of the Adivasi villages in the forest around the Nilgiri Hills, South India. Chembakolli is in the state of Tamil Nadu and its nearest town is Gudalur. We will learn about their transport, schools, houses and homes, toys and games and general village life.
