## Numeracy:

- To be able to divide and multiply whole numbers by 10, 100 and 1000
- To be able to reflect shapes along two lines of symmetry
- Solve a Maths problem using a variety of different methods

## Literacy:

- Be able to identify the key features of a book review and to begin to plan a review of a favourite book
- Spelling rule - using re- before a range of words
- To be able to correctly punctuate sentences using speech marks
- Commence group novels. Please encourage your child to read a book of their choice for a minimum of 15 minutes per night and to complete their Reading Record every Thursday evening.

## Topics:
