

Subject	Unit description
<b>Functional Skills</b> <b>Maths, English, Computing</b>	Students will be working towards the AQA unit award scheme. This includes English, Maths and ICT/computing. They will be working on a variety of tasks to prepare them for future assessments.
<b>AQA</b> <b>Skills for Independent Living</b> <b>Skills for Social Well Being</b> <b>Skills for the Workplace</b> <b>Skills for Leisure</b>	Students will be working towards qualifications covered by the AQA unit award scheme. The qualification will be divided into units covering Communication, Numeracy, ICT, Home Management, Personal Skills and In the Workplace. These units are: Working with others Making a simple meal Shopping in a supermarket Travel Safety Using technology for leisure
<b>Work Experience</b>	Some students will have local external placements and others in-house placements. They will follow a qualification in Work-right or AQA working with others relating to their place of work.
<b>Science</b>	Students will cover electrical safety, changing materials, being healthy, recycling, health and safety, temperatures and plants/growing throughout the different aspects of the curriculum
<b>Humanities</b>	Students will learn about current affairs and other special days which take place during the Autumn Term: This includes things such as Harvest festival, Hull Fair, Bonfire Night and Halloween.
<b>Drama</b>	Students will take part in lessons which will be led by St. Anne's Drama teacher. During this term the students will be developing the theme for 2018 Rock Challenge and take part in a Christmas service.
<b>Community</b> <b>Practical Maths &amp; English</b>	Students will visit a variety of supermarkets. The students will locate items, identify different types of products and ask workers in the shops for assistance when necessary. There will be opportunities to use cafes in the community to experience using money to purchase drinks and snacks.
<b>PSHE</b>	Students will work on the Jigsaw programme, this term they will learn about 'being me in my world' and 'celebrating difference'. This includes looking at how we are similar and different to others, bullying and learning about our likes and dislikes.
<b>PE</b>	This term the students will cover a range of activities within PE, games and dance.
<b>Arts award</b>	This term the students will look at and produce work based on different artists. The 3 artists that they will be researching are Kandinsky, Warhol and Picasso.
<b>RE</b>	This term the students will learn about Festivals and celebrations, they will participate in a ceremony and also complete work about the Christmas story.
