## Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September

Term starts for the children and the doors will open at 8:45am. Children in Years R, 1 and 2 are to use the bottom door. Parents in these classes may come into the building with their children and settle them into school. Remember Year 2, you have moved classrooms!

Children in Reception will finish the school day at 1.15pm for the first two weeks with the Class 1 staff attending home visits during the afternoon.

Years 3 – 6 are to come in via the top door, near classes 3 and 4. Children to be as independent as far as possible and come into school themselves. Obviously if you need to speak to the teacher urgently, then this fine.

At the end of the day, children will leave the school from the same exits.



## Uniform

Please can all uniform be clearly named, including all items of PE kit, and a PE kit should be bought to school on the first day.

## Water bottles

We are asking that this year, all children provide their own named reusable water bottles for school. These should be bought in on the first day and it will be the children's responsibility to take them home daily for cleaning. We are trying to save on our plastic use, as we provide over 100 bottles each year. I am sure the children will prefer to have their own bottle in school which they can choose!
