PGL 2020

After SATS week in May, Mrs McKenna, Miss Bishop, and I took the Year 6 children to Boreatton Park in Shropshire, an outdoor activity centre run by the PGL group. They had a great few days kayaking, climbing, riding on zip wires and much more. We have taken Y6 pupils on these residential holidays for a number of years. It is an exciting activity holiday and something to look forward to after they have worked hard in their final year with us.

Whilst taking rising costs in to consideration, PGL still offers the best value for our pupils. We have booked a 3 day residential trip to Boreatton leaving on Wednesday 20th May and returning on Friday 22th May and we have booked as many activities as we can fit into 3 days!

The total cost of the trip including accommodation, meals, activities and transport is £235 per child. Please note that this trip is partly subsidised by school and the actual cost is over £350 per child. The payment schedule is flexible and you can pay onto your child's PGL account in weekly/monthly instalments if you wish however, the following is a guideline of how much the school must receive by certain dates:

No later than Friday 7 th September 2019	A non-refundable deposit of	£60.00
No later than Friday 22 nd November 2019	A further payment of	£87.50
No later than Friday 14 th February 2020	A final payment of	£87.50
