## 3 PARENTS / GOVERNORS ANNUAL MEETINGS

The School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 (the Act) makes important changes to the previous legislation regarding to Parent/Governors Annual Meetings. It provides new arrangements where parents can ask for a meeting.

Parents will need to satisfy four (4) statutory requirements to call a meeting, namely:  
(a) 10% of registered pupils, or the parents of 30 registered pupils (whichever is the lowest) must sign a petition;

(b) the meeting must be to discuss matters regarding the school;  
(c) the number of meetings parents may request in any school year is three (3);  
(d) there must be enough school days left in the school year to allow for a meeting. Additionally:  
(e) the meeting must be held within a 25 day period;  
(f) the period begins on the day after receiving the petition, but does not include any days that are not school days;  
(g) if a meeting needs to be held due to a different petition, the 25 day period will not begin until the next meeting has been held;  
(d) there must be enough days left in the school year to hold the meeting within the school year;  
(e) the meeting will be open to all parents of registered pupils at the school, the Headteacher and anyone else representing the governing body;  
(f) notification of the meetings to parents must include the date, time and venue, as well as the agenda to be discussed.
