Dear Parents & Carers

Welcome back and we hope you have all had a fantastic summer holiday and enjoyed the sunshine! It was lovely to see all the children keen to be back and looking amazing in their smart uniforms - thank you for your support in ensuring the children of Bellfield Infant school always look so presentable. This is the first year for a long time that we have had no building work during the holidays, which has always lead to some anxious moments nearing the beginning of term. Thank you to Mr Rudge who ensured that our school site was tidy, clean and ready for the new Academic Year!

On Monday we are excited because 'Yoga Bugs' are coming to work with our Early Years children introducing Yoga. Each Year group will have their own session and we know that not only will this improve their physical development, it will also be a very enjoyable experience as the sessions are based around books and stories.

Just a reminder, as we have had several queries, end of school for the Infants Monday to Friday is 3:15pm. We appreciate that this situation can cause inconvenience to you, however, to ensure our children receive their full entitlement, we teach 5 full days a week during the school year.


