Primary Admission for September 2020

If your child has a 4th Birthday between 1st September 2019 & 31 August 2020 they will start primary school in September 2019. You will still need to apply for a place even if your child attends a nursery linked to a primary school. The deadline for applications is 15th January 2020. www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools.
