Create a picture of a savannah in Africa using different materials. You could use paint, pastels, collage... the choice is yours!	Choose a wild animal and compare it to one of the monsters from "Where the Wild Things Are." Draw them and label how they are similar/different.
Make a number track from 0-10 and draw pictures to correspond with each number (e.g. 1 apple, 2 flowers, 3 stars...)	Write a postcard to Handa and tell her about your home and ask her about hers.
Use an atlas, a globe or Google maps to locate where in the world different wild animals are found. Draw a picture of these animals in their habitat.	Draw or paint a wild animal. Use your sounds to add some labels as an extra challenge.
Ask someone at home to draw around you on a big piece of paper. Write some labels for some of the parts of your body.	Play a number game with someone at home. Challenge each other to find set numbers of objects around the house and garden.
