
## English

Topic: Extreme Weather

## Science

Life cycles, living things and their habitats. This term the children will be investigating the life cycles of different animals and looking at the similarities and differences between them. They will also look into different types of habitats.

## P.E.

This term the children will be swimming on Thursdays. In addition, we will be practising basketball at school. They will practise their hand eye coordination and aim for as many shots as possible!

## R.E.

To know the story of Creation in the Bible and reflect on the importance of this story. To understand that God calls us to care for creation and be aware of our responsibilities. Children to make connections between the story and what they can do today to help.



## Topic:

Our topic of Extreme Earth will provide opportunities to explore different types of weather, use geographical knowledge to understand how they come about and begin to explore the effects of extreme weather on our Earth.

## Art and Design Technology:

We will explore water colours to create weather paintings focussing on the sea, following Turner's inspiration, Monet's 'Pond Waterlilies' and David Hockney's 'Pool'. In Design Technology, the children will compete in 'Beat the Flood' challenge.

## French

This term, we will explore French vocabulary describing different weather conditions and seasons. They will think about items of clothing warm at these times.
