

Long Term Plans Autumn 2019 'Into the woods' - woods and forests

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Theme</u>
Maths	This term we will be starting with place value and moving to addition and subtraction in Year 1 and 2.
English	We will be linking our reading and writing to stories in the woods. Fairy tales such 'Little Red Riding Hood' will be starting us off. We will be starting with talk for writing where children retell stories they know and change small parts to make a coherent narrative.
History	Famous Explorers - Marco Polo, John Smith, James Cook and Scott of the Antarctic to link to geographical knowledge of continents and the link to South America and the rainforests
RE	Thinking about God. Exploring God's relationship with human beings and human being relationship with the planet. To explore how God and Jesus give humans teachings to help repair what was spoiled.
PE	Dance, games and yoga to aid mindfulness.
Geography	Examining the names of continents and locations on maps. Compare rainforest to British forests and look at importance of rainforest conservation.

DT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Link to art making forests and jungles • Link to computing design and make a set of traffic lights with and electrical circuit and bulbs.
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plants—Children will examine basic parts of plants and what plants need to grow.
Computing	Children will examine technology around them in everyday life and how it works. They will develop using simple code to emulate technology such as traffic lights.
Music	Hey You ! - Using Rap music and songs to explore pulse and Rhythmn As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other old school hip hop tunes.
