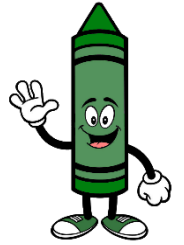


Autumn Term Newsletter

Dear Parents and Carers,

PE

It is important that your child is given the opportunity to read a range of different books in addition to their reading scheme book.

The children will also be sent home with rainbow words, these are for them to practice reading. There will also be a reading morning every Friday in the classrooms until 9.15 which you are welcome to stay and read with your child.

Homework

The children will have their own homework book which will have a range of different activities that they can choose from, to complete over the half term. A letter has been placed into the front of their books explaining the homework, reading and spellings. Homework books need to be brought back to school every Wednesday and they will then be returned back to the children on a Thursday for you to complete the next task.
