#### English

Explore colour and patterns through the work of Gustav Klimt.

##### What were sea-side holidays like in the past?

Learn about the similarities and differences between sea-side holidays in Victorian times, the more recent past and the present day.

##### Who was Grace Darling and what did she achieve?

Learn about why Grace Darling is remembered.

#### Science

Explore the differences between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive.  
Learn about some animals that live in the sea.  
Find out about ocean food chains.  
Learn about the suitability of everyday materials for particular purposes.  
Find out how the shape of solid objects can be changed.

Learn how to be safe when using computers.  
Learn to give instructions to make objects move on screen and how to fix problems.
