Reading in Year 2

Your child will continue to bring home colour banded reading books and a reading diary. They are encouraged to change their reading books each morning. They will need to keep their reading diary and books in their book bags, to bring to school every day. The children will also have lots of opportunities to read and enjoy books throughout the week at school.

Similarly to last year, each Monday one child will be chosen to be Golden Pupil for that week. This child will be responsible for helping with jobs in the classroom throughout the week and demonstrating the traits of a Golden Pupil. On Friday, this child will be celebrated in assembly which you are invited to attend. General Reminders...

- The children should bring a water bottle to school each day to keep in class which they can access throughout the day. Please make sure your child's name is written clearly on their water bottle.
