

Curriculum Map – Nursery Term 1&2 (Sept-Dec 2019)



<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p> <p>Listen to and enjoy stories and rhymes. Begin to use story language. Begin to make marks and start to assign meaning to them. Understand how books work. Retell stories using puppets and small world resources. Find out about information books. Identify words that rhyme and words that begin with the same sound. Start to write lists, letters, invitations etc</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Mathematics</p> <p>Count up to 5, 10 and beyond. Recognise numbers up to 5, 10 and beyond and being able to put them in order. Learn number rhymes. Talk about shapes and their different features. Make patterns. Talk about shape, size and position.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Physical Development</p> <p>Gross motor skills- climbing, running, jumping, riding bikes/scooters Fine motor skills- cutting, pencil control, painting, threading Health awareness- healthy eating, looking after ourselves, keeping clean Keep safe.</p>

Use the small world resources to retell stories and make up our own stories. Make music with the instruments. Build models using the construction resources.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Understanding the world</p> <p>Look at change in the environment. Watch and talk about the new school build and all the exciting things that are happening. Find out about autumn, Diwali, Christmas. Using ICT to support and extend our learning</p>
