KS2 results were significantly improved in all areas. We put this down to targeted interventions and booster classes, systematic testing with focussed Q1st teaching. The progress scores are provisional and have improved from 2018 (in brackets). They are Reading -0.9 (-3.84), writing 0 (-0.4), and maths -0.6 (-3.84). These progress scores are now in-line with national averages. We still have work to do to close these progress scores and this is being addressed by Q1st teaching across the school.

Their results were above national average in all areas and particularly the provision for the more-able is showing pleasing results. We will be focussing on writing at KS1 to ensure that even more children achieve the required standard to ensure we remain well above the national average in all areas.
