The pupil premium grant is additional funding given to schools to support pupils who are considered disadvantaged. The current provision at Meersbrook Bank Primary School is approximately £46,800

Estimated costs have been allocated in the following way:

## Extra-curricular/enrichment

**Overview:** Pupils have the opportunity to learn a musical instrument led by a specialist.

Opportunity to join enrichment activities e.g. sporting clubs, drama, creative writing.

Outdoor residential trip

Cost of visitors/resources for special themed weeks in school

**Cost:** £7000.00

**Aim:** Pupils have a range of opportunities/experiences to improve self-esteem, confidence and to develop a hobby or interest.

## Staff costs and training

**Overview:** Training for staff to support programmes/interventions in school. Professional development opportunities to support all staff in delivering a high-quality curriculum for all. This includes the cost for cover to release staff to monitor teaching and learning. The cost of buying in external professionals e.g. Learn Sheffield package. Also includes some staffing costs to deliver bespoke support for groups/individuals.

**Cost:** £6,000.00

**Aim:** Increased staff knowledge and understanding. A high quality curriculum is in place to support all learners in developing a

## Targeted support for pupils

### **Overview:**

Bespoke support for pupils either 1:1 or in groups to develop their academic/social/emotional needs.

**Cost:** £16,000.00

**Aim:** All pupils have access to bespoke interventions/ staffing in order to achieve their potential and make good progress across the curriculum.

## Resources to enhance learning

### **Overview:**

Purchasing resources to support pupils with their learning e.g. I.T resources/Maths.

**Cost:** £10,000.00

**Aim:** For all pupils to have access to high-quality resources to support their learning/access to the curriculum.

## Improving phonics/reading/writing

### **Overview:**

Purchasing a wide range of books and buying into the Sheffield school library service annually. Buying new books for FS/KS1 to complement their phonics' scheme.

**Cost:** £8000.00

### **Aim:**

To improve outcomes in reading and writing. To enable pupils in FS/KS1 to have access to reading books in school and to take home, that will enhance their learning in phonics and enable them to apply these skills and understanding into their writing. To enable all pupils to have access to a range of reading materials in the school's library.
