As you have probably spotted, there is a video intercom system that links to both the school office and to preschool. If you cannot get a response from the intercom there is also a wireless doorbell (positioned below the intercom) which will alert staff elsewhere in the building that there is a visitor when there is no-one in the office. The gates will be open from **8.45-8.55am**, and from **3.10pm** for afternoon pickup, so please ensure that you arrive at school within those times. Thank you.

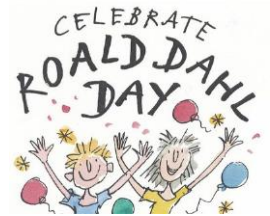
