## Welcome to Nursery

Welcome to the new school year! We have an exciting year ahead planned in Nursery with plenty of activities to keep everyone busy. We will be learning both inside and outside of the Classroom, learning a range of songs and rhymes, creating wonderful works of art and tasting new foods. We will also be visiting the school library every **Thursday** to choose a new book. The children love to take a new book home every week; so don't forget to bring your child's reading folder.

If your child is returning to Nursery or just beginning their journey, I would like to give you some information that will help to settle them in to school.

- Please make sure Nursery children come to school each day in their school uniform. We ask that you clearly label clothing with your child's name (especially jumpers and coats!)
- If possible please ensure that your child can manage their own toileting needs. It might be useful to consider elasticated waist trousers rather than the difficult silver clips some children struggle with. We will of course support your child with toilet training. Please talk to any member of the Nursery staff. Velcro fastening shoes are also a good idea!
- We encourage all of our children to be independent when they are in school. You could support us in this by teaching your child how to put on their own coat and wash their hands properly after using the toilet.

Below are the rules your child will be learning once they are settled into Nursery;

1. We always have kind hands and feet
2. We always use our manners
3. We always follow instructions
4. We always look after property
5. We always walk inside
6. We always use our quiet voice inside
