A letter was sent home with the children's homework on Monday. If you didn't receive a copy, just let us know and we'll print another.



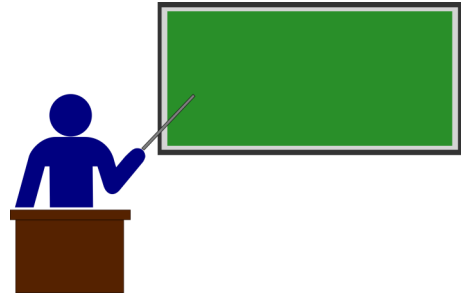
