Welcome to the EYFS and KSI Newsletter. We will try to keep you up to date with things that are happening for children in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2

Thank you!

The children have had a lovely first week back and we would like to thank you for your support with helping the children come in the morning. Next week we will be opening all of the doors at 8.50am for the children to come in when they arrive. We would ask that parents encourage the children to come up the steps on their own.

Homework

There are lots of changes this year to homework and home-reader books. The children have been provided with a homework wallet to keep things in!

Reading

We are encouraging the children to read as often as they can at home with at least ten minutes, three times per week. Every Monday when the children bring in their reading record book we will note how many times they have read and this will be displayed in the classroom. Please would you complete the reading records every time your child reads using one page per week. (See example attached!)

'Must Reads' are also stuck into the reading record books for easy reference.

Spelling

The children are also getting a list of spellings to learn over the half term. These can be displayed at home and do not need to be kept in the homework wallet!

Maths

In the homework wallet there is a maths booklet. This is to be completed and returned on a Monday. The children need to do one page per week.

Topic

Finally there is a grid of ideas related to our topic. These are things that you can do if you wish to do a bit more!! The children do not have to bring anything into school and again the grid does not need to stay in the homework wallet.
