

Literacy

In reading we will be learning about how stories are structured and to describe events, characters and settings of a story. We will also be learning to read initial sounds.

In writing we will be learning to form initial sounds and how to write our name and simple three letter words.

Numeracy Links

We will be learning to say number names in order and how to touch count. We will also be learning to count 3, 4 and 5 from a larger group.

In shape, space and measure we will be looking at 2D shapes and coins.

Understanding the world

We will be looking closely at patterns, changes and differences within our local environment.

We will learn about other peoples beliefs and what is special to us and our families.

Expressive Arts and Design

In our art work we will be investigating colour mixing and how we can change colours.

We will also be signing new songs but learning new ones too!

PSHE

We will demonstrate friendly behaviour and learn play with other children, offering cues for friends to join and listen to others ideas.

We will explore new environments and learn to ask for help when we need it, becoming confident to speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions.

We will learn about our own feelings and that some actions and words can hurt others' feelings. We will share and take turns, following our golden rules.

Communication and Language

We will be learning to sit quietly and listen to stories and recalling key information about the characters and events in the story.

We will be practicing our understanding of instructions and prepositions such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind' by carrying out an action or selecting correct picture.

We will be learning to use more complex language to retell a simple past event in correct order, recalling and relive past experiences.

Physical development

We will learn to be safe in our environment and practice independence in washing and drying hands, putting our coats on ourselves and fastening them.

We will also be learning to form letters correctly using our nip, grip, flip pencil hold.
