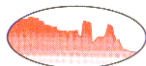

**School Lunches**



As it is the end of the school year can you please logon to ParentPay to make sure that any outstanding amounts for school lunches or trips have been cleared before the end of July. Any credits on the account will be carried over to the next school year for children staying at school. For children leaving the school if there is any credit on the account the credit will be paid back into the account associated with ParentPay. Your help with this is much appreciated.

From September the cost of school lunches for children in Year 3 to Year 6 is £2.40 per day or £12.00 per week. Lunch money for the next half term is £ 93.60. Please note lunches should be paid for in advance and not in arrears. Please logon to your ParentPay account to pay for your school lunches.

Please can we politely remind you that it is not possible for children to swap between a packed lunch or school meal during the week. Please can they have the same choice for the full week. Many thanks.
