This term we are learning...

This half term our theme is 'Pirates'. As historians, children will be learning about the life of Captain Blackbeard and comparing his life to modern day sailors. As designers, the children will be creating and making their own pirate ships. During science lessons we will be looking at different materials and their properties.

Phonics

The children will be focusing on re-capping their phase 2 sounds, phase 3 sounds, tricky words and will also begin to learn some phase 5 sounds. Children will remain in their own classes for Phonics lessons in Year 1.

English

We will be focusing on writing simple sentences which include some tricky words. We will be reading the story 'The Night Pirates' and writing some facts about Pirates.

Maths

We will continue to look at numbers to 20 and make sure we are secure with these numbers before beginning to move onto bigger numbers and quantities. We will be reading, writing and ordering the numbers.
