

ENGLISH



The children will be studying the text, 'The Boy and a Bear on A Boat'. We will be enriching our vocabulary and learning how to write letters for a purpose.



In guided reading we will be exploring the book 'There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom' and responding to the chapter book in a variety of ways. We will focus on specific skills during our reading skills lessons, including how to answer inference questions clearly.

We will also be focusing on handwriting, spelling and grammar.

MATHS

In Maths, the children will learn to :

- read, write, order and compare numbers up to at least 1,000,000 and to determine the value of each digit.
- count backwards in steps of powers of 10 for any given number up to 1,000,000.
- interpret negative numbers through zero and round any number up to 1,000,000
- Solve number problems
- Add and subtract large numbers mentally
- Add and subtract whole numbers using formal written methods, using rounding and inverse methods to check their answers.



ART & DESIGN/D.T

In art , children will refine their skills in using line, tone, colour and perspective when drawing using pencils, charcoal and pens. They will use these skills to draw and decorate maps.

Music


In Music we will be learning the song 'Livin' on a Prayer' and learning how to perform it to an audience.
