- We will be improving our problem solving skills by applying them to practical tasks.

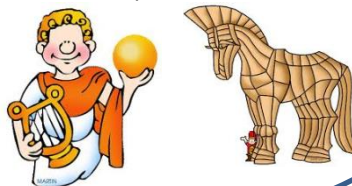
English
