

# School Performance Data

The latest results for 2019 are as follows:

## EYFS

- 86% of pupils achieve a *Good* level of development

## Year 1 Phonics screening check

- 100% of Y1 pupils working at the (WA) the required level

## KS1 Data

- 80% of pupils achieved expected standard in reading
- 67% of pupils achieved expected standard in writing
- 73% of pupils achieved expected standard in maths
- 33% of pupils working at greater depth in reading
- 20% of pupils working at greater depth in writing
- 27% of pupils working at greater depth in maths

## KS2 Data

### Reading (test result)

- The average scaled score was 106
- 79% of pupils achieved expected standard and above
- 36% of pupils working at greater depth/high standard

### Writing (teacher assessment)

- 86% of pupils achieved expected standard and above
- 21% of pupils working at greater depth/high standard

### Maths (test result)

- The average scaled score was 106
- 79% of pupils achieved expected standard and above
- 43% of pupils working at greater depth/high standard
- 79% of pupils achieved expected standard in reading, writing and maths (combined)

## Progress

- Progress from KS1 to KS2 for reading (-0.03) is average
- Progress from KS1 to KS2 for writing (-0.16) is average
- Progress from KS1 to KS2 for maths (+0.08) is average
