

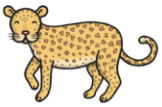


Leopard Class Newsletter!



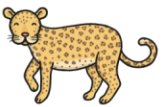
Welcome Back!

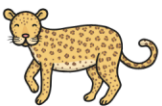
Maths
