Eagles Year 4 Autumn Term 2019

Stone Age

English

This term we will be reading and writing about stories set in imaginary worlds. We will focus on descriptive writing, using adjectives and speech in our writing. Spelling, handwriting and punctuation work will continue throughout the year. Reading for understanding will be very important. We will link our work with our topic whenever possible.

Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and our times table. We will be learning our 6 and 4 times tables, adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers, and beginning to learn how to use the column method for addition and subtraction.

Science

Our first topic is animals including humans. We will be learning how to sort animals using different criteria, and the different dangers posed to animals.



History and Geography

We will be learning about the Stone Age and how people lived during this time. We will learn about their homes, the food they ate, their customs and their traditions. We will have a Stone Age day dressed up as the first humans.

Music

This term we will be learning to play the P bone with 'Inspiring Music'.



RE

We will be learning about Judaism and the key beliefs of the religion. We will read some stories from Judaism and discuss how being a Jew

Art

We will plan, sketch and create Stone Age sculptures out of clay and natural materials. We will begin a sketch book.

PSHCE

This term we will be learning about mental health, stress and how to cope with difficult emotions. We will learn about the importance of sleep in staying healthy.

French

We will be learning how to respond to classroom instructions, the vowels, zoo animals and clothing. We will also stage a short play in French.

Computing

We will be formatting graphics to create posters. We will also learn how to programme and code, as well as how to keep safe online. We will give multi-media presentations.



PE

We will be learning to play tag rugby this term with premier sport. Some of us will be participating in a tag rugby tournament in the local area.

We will learn how to design, make, evaluate and use technical knowledge to strengthen, stiffen and reinforce more complex structures.
