Pen Recycling

We are delighted to announce that we are now an official Bic Community Champion drop off location for pen recycling. Please bring all used pens, highlighters, markers, biro and correction fluid pots to school and place them in the collection box, which will be located in the under-cover area. We cannot accept pencils, crayons, glue sticks, rulers, erasers or cutting objects that might disturb the recycling process so please ensure you do not include any of these items in your recycling. When our box is full we can send it back to Terracycle and earn cash rewards for our school. Once collected, the writing instruments are separated by material composition, cleaned and melted into hard plastic that can be remoulded to make new recycled products.

Please spread the word to your family and friends so that the whole of the local community can get involved!
