Bedgrove Fireworks 2019

Join us for our fantastic annual evening of fireworks to celebrate the end of half-term

Tickets will be sold on a first come, first served basis via Bedgrove Junior School Office. Tickets need to be purchased for both adults and children. Children aged 2 and under are free but must still have a ticket. **Please have the correct money ready as the office won't be able to give change.**

Entrance will be through the main gate of the JUNIOR SCHOOL ONLY from 5.30pm. The back gates will **NOT** be open. The firework display will start at approx. 7pm and the event will be finished by 8pm.

Fireworks - Due to the size of our site, and the proximity of the spinney, our display will be made up of lower level and medium level pyrotechnics. We have again been able to secure the services of a local company for the display who have worked on high profile events such as the Big Brother finale fireworks since 2002, The Rolling Stones tours and the Golden Jubilee. They were also the 2010 British Firework Champions. They are able to make even the lower level displays incredibly spectacular.

Refreshments – The PTA will have a bar and tuck shop available, plus there will be a few food vendors selling a variety of food and drink options. The vendors will each be giving a percentage of their profits to the school.

Supporting Us - There will also be a variety of Glow in the dark & light up novelties for sale on the night. These are battery powered. They will cost between £1 and £3.50 each.

Safety - Following County regulations, to ensure the safety of all persons coming to the event, we ask that sparklers and other fireworks are not brought with you on the night.

We are expecting up to 2000 spectators to come to the event. Spectators will be standing on the school field and so suitable footwear would be recommended. There will be a significant safety zone set up around the firing zone and so space on the field will be limited to standing room only. There will not be space for families to have picnics or bring chairs to the event. We will have a limited number of portable toilets on site for the evening as the schools will not be open.

Parking - With such a large gathering we ask that you show consideration for the local residents and walk to the event where at all possible. This will reduce the congestion on the roads and emergency services must have easy access along Ingram Avenue should they be needed. If you must drive please park considerately. The local police will be aware of the event and may come along too.
