


West Butterwick C of E Primary School Curriculum Coverage Autumn 2019



Dear Parents/Carers,

I am pleased to welcome Class Two back after the Summer break and can say we have already made a good start to our topic work. We have already found out about some historical information about the Stone Age.

In Science, we'll be finding out:

- To recognise that living things have changed over time.
- To describe how fossils are formed.



In Geography, we'll be finding out:

- Name and locate counties and cities of the UK, geographical regions and their human and physical characteristics (mountains, hills, coasts and rivers) and land-use patterns; and understand how some of these aspects have changed over time.

In History, we'll be finding out:

- Changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.
- Late Neolithic hunter-gatherers and early farmers (Skara Brae)
- Bronze Age technology and travel (Stonehenge)
- Historical sources tell us.

In Art and Design, we'll be finding out:

- To improve techniques, including drawing and painting with a range of materials.
- To create stone and iron art.

In PE, we'll be:

- To develop coordination and static and dynamic balancing skills.
- Swimming - swim 25metres, use a range of strokes and perform a self-rescue in water.
- Play competitive games.
- Y5/6 take part in outdoor adventurous activity individually and in teams (PGL).

In Computing, we'll be finding out:

- Year 3 and 4 - Coding, online safety and spreadsheets.
- Year 5 and 6 - Coding, online safety and spreadsheets.

In PSHE, we will be finding out:

- **Year 3 and 4** - Identity, society and equality: Democracy, Drug, alcohol and tobacco education: Making Choices
- **Year 5 and 6** - Drug, alcohol and tobacco education: Weighing up the risk, Identity, society and equality: Human rights

In French we will be learning:

- clothing
- colours and adjectival endings
- expressing opinions
- creating conversations



In RE, we will be exploring:

- Investigating Visions and Hopes
- What does it mean if God is holy and loving?

This term, we continue with Miss Marshall, who provides Class Two with specialist music lessons (recorders and ukuleles) and Mrs Cressey will continue to provide French and Science lessons.

Additional Information:

- Outdoor P.E kit will be required on Monday and Thursday. Please can kits be brought into school on a Monday just in case our plans change based on the weather. As part of our health and safety rules, the children are not allowed to wear earrings so they must be able to take them out themselves or provide their own plasters to cover them.
- Spellings will be handed out on Thursday (Y3/4) and Friday (Y5/6) and tested the following week. We will be checking the children's spelling and times table booklets during the week so please ensure these are in school every day. The children would benefit from reading three times a week. If they achieve this, they receive team points as a reward. If you have any questions about the children's homework, please feel free to contact me.
