We have also had some very exciting experiences and trips throughout the school this year.

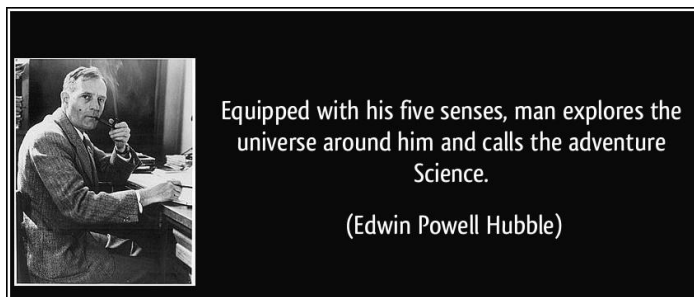
In year 5 we had a virtual reality space experience!
