Today we take off on our Reading Mile Challenge!

Your children have received a passport today with space for them to record their progress round the world.

Every time they read a book that is NOT an Oxford Reading Tree book, they must record how many pages they have read and you must sign to say that this is true. They will then share them with their class teacher who will record the pages they read.

The back of the passport shows the maps and the stop-gaps between destinations. They move from one stop-gap to the next every time they have read 50 pages for pleasure. Children will earn rewards for reaching each destination on their passport.

Attached are some suggestions of the different types of books that your child may enjoy. These are available in the school library as well as the local library. We hope that you get involved in encouraging your child read for pleasure as the benefits are immeasurable.
