TOP TIPS FOR READING WITH YOUR CHILD

1. Read something every day
2. Read to your child; share stories, poems, magazines, anything.
1. Join a library
2. Let your children see you reading; be their model
1. Keep it short – for some children 10 minutes everyday is great. Quality time is better than a long time.
2. Find a quiet space; away from screens and noise.
3. Use the pictures to help.
4. Ask simple questions about what they have read.
5. Praise the effort.
6. Any problems, don't worry, speak to your class teacher.
