Drama Knowledge

Pupils develop their knowledge of drama and theatre by studying a set text (Blood Brothers) and critically evaluating a piece of live theatre.

Assessment: (40% of GCSE)

- Written exam at the end of Yr 11

Devising

Pupils develop their understanding of drama and theatre through the creation of a piece of live theatre.

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Assessment: (40% of GCSE)

- Performance (10%)
- Devising Log (30%)

Texts in Practice

Pupils develop their knowledge of drama through the study and performance of two extracts from a published play text.

Assessment: (20% of GCSE)
