Quality of PE Provision

Provision in PE lessons continues to be of a high quality. Sports premium allows us to continually develop and extend the range of sports available in extracurricular clubs for both key stages. This in turn, develops the skill levels demonstrated by children in PE lessons.

There are a growing number of children who appear on our gifted and talented list for PE. Some of these are currently representing county or professional clubs, notably in gymnastics, football, swimming and netball.

Over the year, staff have received CPD training to enhance and develop their pedagogies of teaching PE. This has enabled staff to become more confident in teaching a range of sports as well as helping them think about differentiation and positive participation within sports.

School Games Award

Our programme of extracurricular opportunities combined with our entries in to school based and externally organised competitions has enabled us to achieve the Bronze and Silver school games award. Now the P.E lead has experience in the criteria of these awards, we will be aiming for Gold this year.
