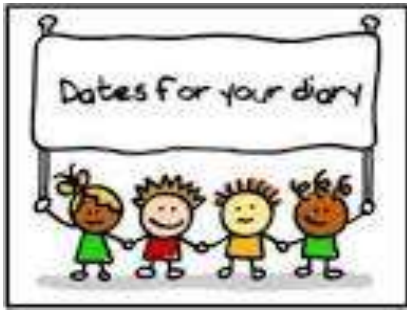
I wish your children every success this year and to keep in mind our three school rules, To be ready, to be respectful and to be safe.
