RESOURCEFUL ROCHDALE

Maths

We will be working on place value and addition and subtraction this term. We will be learning our 2,5,10X tables and learning our number bonds to 10 and to 20.

Writing

Our class text for the term is, 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. We will be using this as inspiration to write our own stories and non-fiction reports about tigers. We are focusing on sentence structure and using adjectives in our writing.

Reading

We will begin to develop our comprehension skills with a focus on using evidence from the text to support our ideas. We will also be working on our phonics and guided reading skills.

Science

In science we will be looking at Materials. We will be classifying them, looking at their properties and testing them to see what they can be used for. We will look at how materials change when we heat, cool, stretch and cut them.

Computing

We will be learning about internet safety and rules for keeping safe online. After half term we will begin to use the internet for our own research.

Creative Curriculum

We will be looking at famous people from around Rochdale/North West from the Victorian era. We will look at local history and begin to learn about the history of Rochdale—whilst using maps and atlases to show where we are in the world. Please encourage your children to find out about Sir Robert Peel, a famous person that we will be researching this term.

Our new topic is learning all about Resourceful Rochdale.



Music

This term we will be focusing on singing and playing musical instruments.



PE

Our Autumn term will see us developing our ball and gymnastics skills.

RE

Our focus will be Christianity. We will be looking at sacred texts and special books. This will include The Bible and The Torah.

PSHCE

We will focus on physical wellbeing and good health. We will also look at keeping safe and managing risks.
