BRITAIN 'POST 1066'

Maths

This term, we will look at place value and mental & written calculation methods. We shall also be exploring measurements and statistics by measuring the perimeter of the playground, and creating graphs from surveys completed in and around school.

Writing

We are starting the year with traditional tales but with a twist! We will be retelling some of the most well known stories, using our imaginations, to create a different ending. We shall be using drama and our favourite books for inspiration.

Reading

We will look at developing our comprehension skills with a focus on using evidence from the text to support our ideas, predictions and discussions.

Science

This term we will be covering 'animals including humans' followed by 'forces and magnets' after half term. Through these topics we will be learning what our body needs to be healthy and how to safely set up and carry out experiments.

Computing

This term we will be learning keeping safe online. Please talk to your children about this and be aware of what they are accessing at home.

Creative Curriculum

Our new topic is learning Britain 'Post 1066'. Through this topic we shall look at changes in Britain after the battle of Hastings. As part of this topic, we will consider Britain's involvement in WW2, how the war began and how this moment in history shaped changes for the future.



Music

In Music we will be working on developing our skills on a variety of instruments.

PE

Our autumn term will see us developing our gross motor skills and improving our strategies in working as a team.

RE

In RE we shall be studying Christianity, discussing "When was Jesus born?" and "Where do Christians worship Jesus?"

We will be focusing on improving our confidence and developing a positive mindset that we can apply to all areas of our lives.

MFL

In French we will be learning about how to greet others and introduce ourselves in French and say the numbers from 0-20.
